The interns will be responsible for the handling and operation of the equipment under the supervision of responsible faculties.

Scope of work:

1. To order laboratory reagent and consumables.
2. Maintenance of lab logbook and maintenance book
3. Handling and operation of laboratory equipment
4. Conduct basic experiments by utilizing equipment available at NTIC
5. Field visit for testing and accreditation process

Desired qualification and experiences:

1. Students from Undergraduate 4th year and Masters level with background preferably in Biotech, Pharmacy and Environment Engineering/Science
2. Excellent communication / writing skills (Both English and Nepali)
3. Good Command over office packages

Duration:

The Internship period will be of 3 months. Only shortlisted candidates will be notified for interview with decision from selection committee. Selected candidates are expected to join immediately. The internship period will be voluntarily basis.
